(Merchandise vendors)

There are currently 25 states with e-waste laws, or EPR laws (Extender Producer Responsibility). EPR laws were established to require electronic manufacturers to recycle their own products: whatever you sell, you are obligated to recycle. These laws must be followed in order for your brand to be sold at Best Buy.

In each regulated state, brands must do three things:

- 1. Submit an annual registration form
- 2. Pay an annual fee
- 3. Submit sales data to the state

Each state has different registration forms, fees and reporting requirements. Please refer to the <u>ERCC website</u> for a full list of e-waste regulations and deadlines. Click into each individual state for state-specific information.

*Note: Only certain types of electronics apply to these laws: TVs, tablets, monitors, computers, digital picture frames, screened items over 5", etc. Refer to the ERCC website for a full list of electronics that are covered in the EPR laws.
